Food Safety

- 604 – Temporary Food Service
 - (1-14days)
- 605 - Food Service Establishment / Statewide Mobile (Food Truck)
 - Requires Food Manager and food handler cards
 - (6months / 180 days)
- 607 – Food Service and Retail Food (Kroger)
 - Requires Food Manager and food handler cards
 - (180 days)
- 610 – Retail only (Sav-a-Lot)
 - (1 year / 360 days)



Other Programs

- 620 – Hotel / Motel (Holiday Inn Express)
 - 10% of total rooms inspected
 - Inspection period (360 days)
- 625 – Mobile Home / RV Parks
 - Inspection period (360 days)
- 634, 643, 644 – Tattoo Studio, ear piercing, body piercing
 - Inspection period (180 days)
- 635 – Schools
 - Inspection period (180 days)
 - Includes cafeterias (605)
- 650 – Youth Camp (Falling Springs)
 - Inspection period (360 days)



680 – On-Site Septic Systems

- Site Evaluation
- Permit
- Continuous Inspection



695 - Public Swimming Pool Program

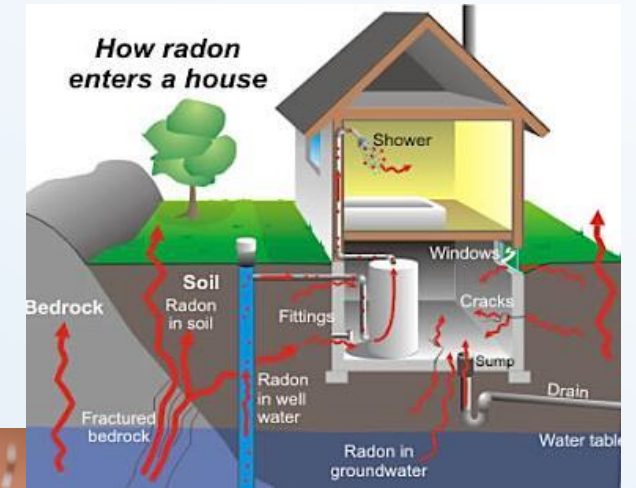
- Inspected twice a season or 180 days for indoor pools.
- Indoor Pool: Holiday Inn Express





Other Programs

- 636 – Mold Program
- 655 – Private Water Testing (wells)
- 660 – Nuisance Control (Mosquito, Rodent, etc..)
- 676 – Radon
- 685 – Private Sewage (complaints)
- 697 – Rabies Program
- 811 – Childhood Lead Program (Lead risk assessments for children 6 & under)

- State plumbing Inspector is in office Monday's only from 8-930am.
- \$40 plan review fee, paid to WCHD
- Restaurants require
 - Handwash sink
 - 3-compartment sink
 - Mop sink
