

COVID-19 VACCINATION DECISION TREE

Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine
 ≥12 years old: 0.3mL x 2 doses 21 days apart
 5-11 years old: 0.2mL X 2 doses 21 days apart

Moderna Vaccine
 ≥18 years old: 0.5 mL X 2 doses 28 days apart

mRNA vaccines are preferred for primary and booster doses
Janssen (J&J) Vaccine
 ≥18 years: 0.5 mL single dose

Moderate to severely Immunocompromised

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3rd Additional Dose

- Moderna ≥18 year old
- Pfizer ≥ 5 years old

≥ 28 days after primary series completed.
 Same dose as primary series

2nd Additional Dose

- Moderna_ or Pfizer ≥18 year old
- ≥ 28 days after primary JJ vaccine.
- Moderna 0.5mL or
- Pfizer 0.3mL

***Pfizer-BioNtech Dose 0.3ml**
 ≥ 5 months after primary series completed
 ≥ 12 years of age

***Moderna Dose 0.25ml**
 *≥5 months after primary series completed
 ≥ 18 years of age

Janssen (JJ) Dose 0.5ml
 ≥2 months after primary series completed
 ≥ 18 years of age

***Providers may provide heterologous ("mix and match") booster doses to eligible individuals following completion of primary vaccination**

CDC recommends that people remain up to date with their vaccines, which includes additional doses for individuals who are immunocompromised or booster doses at regular time points. Individuals who are moderately or severely immunocompromised should get an additional primary shot and a booster shot.

*Those individuals that received mRNA vaccines and are moderately or severely immunocompromised and ≥12 years old should receive a booster 3 months after completion of the primary series and may receive a total of four COVID-19 vaccine doses
